

In early June Kenny Adams told me of an article Tom Price wrote to the Leatherneck Magazine about his part in the Jefferson Highway Convoy. Below is that article with a photo from the JH24 Convoy Picture Archives. I can't tell how this makes me feel. His article he submitted to us and he won't get to see it in the Tool Crib.

**ATTENTON: SOUND OFF EDITOR**  
**SUBJECT: Convoy of Military Vehicles.**

I recently took part in a convoy of civilian restored Military Vehicles, of 28 days.

The purpose of this convoy was and is to Honor all Veterans and Active Duty Military. We also travel these miles to teach our younger generations the importance of Military history.

Throughout the many days of travel, there were 28 to 32 vehicles from WWII to the 1980s in the convoy. As we drove through many states from north to south, we had others proudly join us from states where they lived, in their MV's.

My vehicle was the only Marine Corps vehicle, a 1960 M 422E1 Mighty Mite pulling a XM 585E7 prototype trailer, picture attached.

The Mighty Mite was built from 1959 to 1963 by American Motors for the Marine Corps to be moved with helicopters. As it is all aluminum, weighing an average of 1700 pounds.

Driving one of the smallest vehicles in attendance, I was near the back position of our march units. My vehicle was a tremendous hit by everyone along the way. The general public expressed to me, that they had never seen one. To my surprise, there was also Marines that I met while on the highway, that had never seen one either.

We convoyed the Jefferson Highway, which went from Winnipeg, Canada to New Orleans, Louisiana. The well-established highway, was built in the early 1900s. Our group started at the Canadian border in Minnesota and ended in New Orleans.

I had over 2750 miles on my loyal ride, with only a few problems in the beginning.

From the extreme coldest of days, to the very hottest of days. In Marine Corps style: Honor, Courage and Commitment, I overcame those few problems and finished the convoy.
