

Next meeting is at the Toronto Rod and Gun Club, 13824 OH-152, Toronto, OH 43964. Below are instructions that the Pizzoferrato's sent me. If you'd like to possibly spend the night in the area I do have hotel/motels in the area so just ask and I'll send.

If following a GPS please review your route first to avoid these things:

If coming from the North West, SE of Canton Ohio near Carrollton Ohio, your GPS may want you to take SR 171 from SR 43 and head towards Mechanicstown and Bergholz. DO NOT do this. Remain on SR 43 through Carrollton into Richmond, then take SR 152 North. Ignore your GPS until you get into Richmond.

From the West, you should end up on US 22. You can take SR 152 North from US 22 at Bloomingdale. If pulling a trailer, stay on US 22 until Wintersville /US 43 exit, turn left on US 43 to Richmond, then take SR 152 North.


From the North East: From SR 7 South you can take SR 213 South. Your GPS may direct you to CR 51 (Hollow Rock Rd). DO NOT take CR 51/Hollow Rock if pulling a trailer; DON'T DO IT; Seriously DON'T!). This route is fine if no trailer or towed vehicle is involved. You can bypass Hollow Rock Rd and continue on SR 213 South to SR 152 South. With a trailer, you should probably just remain on SR 7 South into Empire, then take SR 152 South.

From the South: from Steubenville Ohio, take SR 7 N to US 22 West to SR 43 into Richmond to SR 152 North. Any other suggested GPS route from Steubenville requires you to have mountain goat DNA.

The ride after the meeting will be about a 29 mile loop consisting of 7 miles of State Routes and 22 miles of County and Township Roads (more than half of this section will be unpaved roads through the Brush Creek Wildlife Area.

As you can see not many roads down there so please follow the instructions above. We'd like to see members from this area as we've never been in southeastern Ohio for a meeting.

Meeting is as usual. Potluck so bring a dish and your drink if other than water. Lunch at noon and meeting afterwards. David and Donna have a trail ride set up so if you can bring your MV that would be great. The area is mostly forests and will be a beautiful ride.


