Recently we've had a couple of fires that destroyed some important military history. One fire was at MAPS Air Museum of Ted Mathies Vietnam Medical tent and contents. Quite a few of you will remember Ted had his display at all of the MVPA conventions we hosted, 2006, 2011 and 2017.

**GREEN** — The City of Green Fire Division is investigating a Nov. 3 fire at MAPS Air Museum, 2260 International Parkway, that destroyed an outdoor exhibit featuring a replica Vietnam-era Mobile Army Surgical Hospital (MASH).

"It was a personal collection that was a permanent exhibit — disabled [by the airport] in the winter — and unfortunately included a lot of [irreplaceable] Vietnam-era items," said Green Fire Division Public Information Officer Jeremy Chambers. "The tent and almost all its contents are a complete loss. We haven't determined a cause at this time."


Chambers said the Akron-Canton Airport (CAK) air traffic control tower initially reported the fire at 11:15 p.m. The airport's Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting team was the first to arrive on scene, with Green Fire crews arriving shortly thereafter. The fire was reportedly fully extinguished by 11:47 p.m.

Chambers said there was minimal damage to the MAPS building, with the fire contained to the MASH exhibit and two exterior windows of the museum. In a Nov. 4 press release, Green Fire Chief Jeff Funai commended members of both the Green Fire Division and the CAK fire team.

"CAK's fire team was first on the scene and had the fire under control by the time our crews arrived," Funai said. "As the primary responders for any fire or medical emergency at Akron-Canton Airport, our partnership and joint training with CAK's fire team [was] essential to minimizing damage to this cherished museum."


I found this on Facebook. Not sure who wrote the first part.

November 4, 2025 - Butler, PA. The historic Bantam Jeep factory — where the original Jeep legacy was born — has been lost to a devastating fire. This is a profound loss for the entire Jeep community and for American automotive history.

We at Kaiser Willys want to thank the brave firefighters who battled the blaze and worked tirelessly to protect what they could. Though the building is a loss, the Jeep spirit lives on — in every restoration, every trail, and every member of the Jeep family who keeps this legacy alive.

From what I've read they don't know what caused the fire. Much of the Bantam factory had already been torn down years ago. The vacant administrative building remained, serving as an actual monument to the birthplace of the Jeep, but also a sad reminder of the decline of American industry in the late 20th century.

2 unexplained fires within a week of each other. Sad to see the history go like this.


